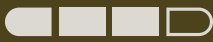

Tatamy Tweed

45% Cotton
55% Acrylic

4, (5, 5, 6, 7) skeins
Oatmeal or color of your
choice



Light

Finished waist measurement
26" (30", 32", 34", 38")

GAUGE

22 sts and 34 rows =
4" / 10 cm
over pattern stitch



U.S. 5 / 3-3/4 mm
circular needle
2 U.S. 4 / 3-1/2 mm double
pointed needles for tie
or size needed to
obtain gauge

Large-eye Needle
Stitch markers

Flirty Skirty

A lovely addition to any lady's wardrobe. This is a great skirt knit in the round using a cute lace stitch pattern. Great for the beach or for lounging around. Our Tatamy Tweed makes this an easy care garment that gets softer as time goes by. It is sure to become a favorite.

Notes:

1. Skirt is secured with an I cord tie threaded through yarn overs in the waist band.
2. Skirt is knit in three tiers with increases between them.
3. Pattern is written for smallest size with larger sizes in parentheses. If only one number is given it applies to all sizes.
4. To make skirt longer, add more lace patterns always ending with row 10 of pattern. If you do make skirt longer remember to pick up more yarn.

Stitch Patterns

Round 1 - K1, *ssk, (K1, yo) twice, K1, K2tog, K1; rep from * to end of round.

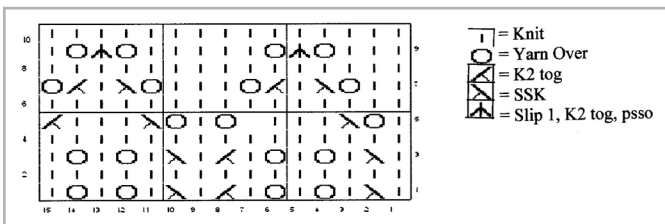
Round 2 and all even rounds - K around

Round 3 - same as round 1 of Lace Pattern

Round 5 - K1, *yo, ssk, K3, K2tog, yo, K1; rep from * to end of round

Round 7 - K2, *yo, ssk, K1, K2tog, yo, K3; rep from * to last 2 sts, K2

Round 9 - K3, *yo, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yo, K5; rep from * to last 3 sts, K3



I Cord Tie:

Using dpn CO 3 sts

Slide sts to right hand side of needle and K the sts
DO NOT TURN

Slide sts to right hand side of needle and K the sts
Repeat until desired length

Flirty Skirty

Worked in the round from the top down.

Waistband

Cast on 144 (168, 176, 192, 208) sts

Placing stitch marker at beginning of round, work in rounds as follows:

Round 1 - *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of round

Round 2 - Same as round 1

Round 3 - *K2tog, yo, P2tog, yo; repeat from * to end of round

Round 4 - Same as round 1

Round 5 - Same as round 1, inc in last st 145 (169, 177, 193, 209) sts

Start Lace Pattern

Round 1 - K1, *ssk, (K1, yo) twice, K1, K2tog, K1; repeat from * to end of round

Round 2 and all even rounds - K to end of round

Round 3 - Same as round 1 of Lace Pattern

Round 5 - K1, *yo, ssk, K3, K2tog, yo, K1; rep from * to end of round

Round 7 - K2, *yo, ssk, K1, K2tog, yo, K3; rep from * to last 2sts, K2

Round 9 - K3, *yo, sl 2, K1, P2sso, yo, K5; rep from * to last 3 sts, K3

Round 10 - Same as round 2 of Lace Pattern

Repeat these 10 rounds 5 times

End Tier 1 increase

Round 1 - P to end of round

Round 2 - K around increasing 32 times evenly spaced by using yo, 177 (201, 209, 225, 241) sts

Round 3 - P to end of round

Tier 2

Work 10 rounds of Lace Pattern 7 times

End Tier 2 Increase

Round 1 - P to end of round

Round 2 - K around increasing 64 times evenly spaced by using yo, 241 (265, 273, 289, 305) sts

Round 3 - P to end of round

Tier 3

Work 10 round of Lace Pattern 5 timers

Tier 3 Ending

Next Round - P to end of round

Next Round - K to end of round

Next Round - P to end of round

Picot Edging

BO2, *sl st on right-hand needle to left-hand needle, CO 2 sts, BO 4 sts; repeat from * until all sts are bound off

Sew in all ends neatly

Thread I-cord through the yarn overs of round 3

Follow washing instruction from skein band and block to shape
